Genetics in research and innovation

Advances in research into the genetic course of disease has lead to new hope for therapeutic development

Genetic therapies are not a pipe dream

Research laboratories often funded by patient groups are moving to a translational phase

Genetic therapies are a reality

Luxturna for a rare form of childhood blindness approved by FDA in USA and received CHMP approval on Friday September 21, 2018

Genetic Therapies herald new era of healthcare delivery

Personalised medicines, including gene therapies, will target disease revolutionising delivery of treatments and cures for unmet needs









WHAT DOES A GENETIC DIAGNOSIS MEAN AND WHY IS IT IMPORTANT

- 300,000 Irish people will be affected by a rare disease in their lifetime - 80% of rare diseases are genetic in origin.
- One of the largest health constituencies in Ireland yet it remains one of the most marginalised and least served.
- To truly understand the course of genetic diseases, ranging from life limiting disease to physical and/or sensory disease, often with mental and physical developmental delays, a genetic test is required.







STATE OF PLAY....

In Ireland today...

Waiting lists for a diagnosis are increasing year on year

- Currently over 2,800 people on waiting list
 - An increase of 400 from 2017
- 500 people are waiting more than 18 months
 - An increase of 66% compared to 2017







GENETIC SERVICES

In Ireland today...

Because of a lack of investment...

- 4 WTE Consultant Clinical Geneticists
- 6.2 WTE Genetic Counsellors

A counsellor provides diagnosis and impact on prognosis of disease, they need to meet not only affected person but also with all members of a family.
